Have you ever seen piranhas beeing fed? If not, here is your chance. The **Tropicarium** in Budapest houses hundreds of **exotic animals** (alligators, exotic birds, sharks etc.). With a tourguide from our exotic animal department you will take a close look at these fascinating creatures.

In the afternoon join us for a rare dissection at our **exotic animal department** where we have had all kinds of animals cured in the past years.

The **zoo** is always interesting for future vet students, especially if a **professional guide** helps to see what you may not have noticed earlier in other zoos. Let us show you the animals from a little closer!

DAY 6: Have you ever tried finding a vein on a dog's leg or put them on an IV? If not, you can try it in our **skills lab** where our colleagues will help you practice!
