1.	16 Sept.	Swine 1. Anaesthesiology and surgical procedures: Methods, tools and execution of anaesthesiology Tools of surgical procedures. Cesarean section. (<i>A. Horváth</i>)
2.	23 Sept.	Swine 2. Anaesthesiology and surgical procedures: Tail clipping, teeth clipping, bleeding of the navel, splay leg, castration: surgical and non-surgical methods (piglet, grower, boar), surgical removal of undescended testicles, inguinal hernia correction surgery, rectal prolapse, cervical prolapse, uterine prolapse, producing a heat detection boar (<i>A.
