



ANNOUNCEMENT ERASMUS+ SCHOLARSHIP 2023/2024

I would like to inform the students of the faculty that we invite applications to the academic year of 2023/2024 for Erasmus+ student scholarship. The aim of the ERASMUS+ program is to promote students in gaining international experience, learning in a foreign country and to experience the European dimension.

Conditions of student mobility:

- only full-time, active students are eligible to become ERASMUS+ students which means that all ERASMUS+ students must register and pay the normal tuition fee to our faculty including during the period spent abroad
- at least two completed semesters at the sending institution
- citizenship of any of the countries participating in the ERASMUS+ program (EU member states + Norway, Liechtenstein, Iceland, Turkey), or being nationals of other countries, supposing that they are having either a permanent resident status or refugee status in Hungary.
- appropriate language proficiency (language of instruction of the certain institute)
- study plan, which is accepted by the home and the host institution
- being ready to take supplementary examinations, if necessary, after returning

Students are ranked based on their grades (GPA), language competence. Status of Student:

- ERASMUS+ student: receives a scholarship (around 470-670 Euro/month)
- ERASMUS+ label-student: has the same rights and obligations like an ERASMUS+ student but does not receive scholarship (please indicate on your application form if you are ready to apply also for this status)

- ❖ The ERASMUS+ program offers grants to students attending a European partner university for a minimum of 3 months (for traineeships a minimum of 2 months) to a maximum of one year (see table of partner institutions).
- ❖ Courses taken by students can only be accredited if they are a part of the curriculum of the mother institution.
- ❖ ERASMUS+ grant (around 470-620 Euro/month) will not cover all additional costs of the study period abroad (travel costs, accommodation, meals, insurance, etc.)
- ❖ The goal of the university is to see that the most talented and knowledgeable students receive scholarships. For this reason, the student's grades and scientific, professional, and social involvement are the most important factors in the selection process.
- ❖ Applying to the student's home country is possible, however they are considered with the lowest priority.
