- You will be responsible for the treatment and clinical assessment of sea turtles at our centre.
- Along with continuing our TNR program, you will also manage our veterinary clinic where you will spay, vaccinate, and treat domestic and stray cats. Thus, the ability to carry out cat neutering procedures unsupervised is essential.
- You will instruct college students on sea turtle treatment and cat surgery as part of our veterinary student program.
