The name of the boat is *Táncsics*.

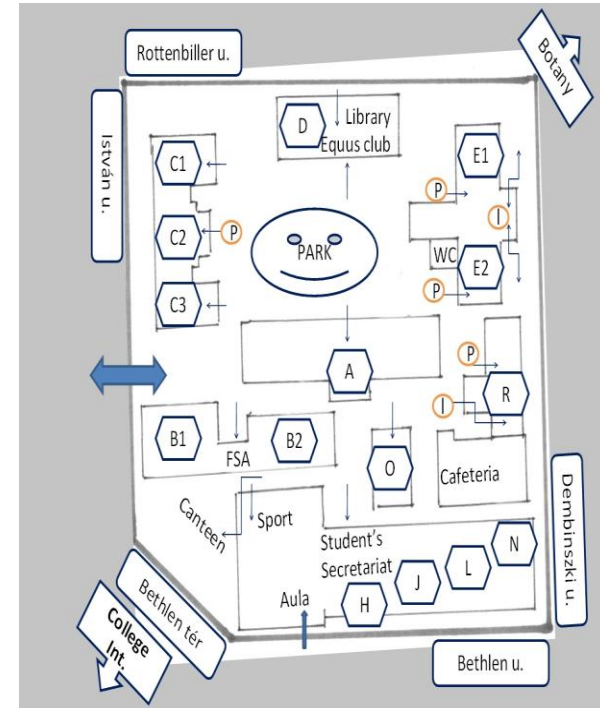
