



Frequently asked questions concerning the

SUMMER PRACTICE

IV. year

1. - What is the summer practice?

- At the end of the IV. year, during the summer holiday every student must participate a 4 week- long practice where the students can take part mainly in the healthcare of the domestic animal species (cat, dog, ruminants, horse, swine).

2. – When is it?

- You can carry out this 4-week long practice between the end of the exam period and the beginning of the next semester. 2022. 07.04.- 09.11.

3. – Where can I do this?

- For the Hungarian students it is obligatory to spend a part of this practice (2 weeks) in the University's Clinincs. Regarding the limited places of the University's clinical establishments, we would like to encourage you to *spend this practice in your home country or where you have opportunity.*

However, you have the possibility to join in the clinical work at the University's Small Animal Clinic or at the Horse Clinic, if there will be enough place after the registration of the Hungarian students (in May).

4. – What is my task connected with this practice?

- It is advisory for you to find a clinic/ a vet or a farm where you can spend this practice and organise it to yourself, as soon as possible.

5. - Are there any special requirements that the place of the practical should meet?

- It should provide veterinary service for domestic animals (horses, swine, ruminants, dog, cat), otherwise it may be any of the following types of veterinary practices: teaching hospital, hospital, clinic, mobile practice, emergency facility, specialty facility, center etc. (A maximum of 2 weeks from the practical is allowed to be spent at veterinary facilities dealing with exclusively/partly exotic or zoo animal species).

6. - Can I do this practice at a place dealing with exotic animals? For example at a zoo or exotic clinics?

- Yes, you can, but only 2 weeks, so the half of the practice.



7. – What is my task during the practice?

- Your task is to participate in the animal examinations and help with the treatments and get the certificate filled out.

8. – Fulfilling this practical, how will it be accepted within my educational program?

- A *certificate and evaluation form* must be filled in by the supervisor of the practice and this certificate must be given to the Obstetrics Department in the beginning of the next semester (in September).

9. – Can I spend my summer practice in the University's Clinics?

- Yes, you can, if there will be enough place after the registration of the Hungarian students (in May). Every year there are some free places in the Small Animal Clinic and in the Horse Clinic as well. If you are interested in it, please let the organiser (see below) know it.

10. – How can I apply to this practice?

- You don't have to apply to this practice, because the Students Secretariat will do this to everybody via Neptun.

If you want to spend the summer practice at a University clinic, you have to apply by e-mail. We will ask the contact person to gather the names of the students, who want to do their practice in Hungary.

11. – Who is the responsible for this practice?

- The organiser is the Department of Obstetrics and Food Animal Medicine Clinic - dr. Anna Csepreghy and dr Mónika Bacsa. They are responsible for the organisation and registration of the Hungarian students to the Clinics of the University. They will do the schedule for the Small Animal Clinic as well.
