You need to register for the following courses:

What courses to sign up in neptun? - Cross 11th (practical) semester:

You have to register for the following courses and choose the Abroad course in each blocks!

Thesis progress report 2. (marked with the name of the department where you write your thesis with)

clinical blocks: Farm animal medicine 4/8 weeks, + Equine medicine OR Small animal medicine OR Exotic animal medicine (altogether 12 weeks, all abroad)

Laboratory diagnostics (2 weeks, abroad)

State veterinary medicine (2 weeks, abroad)

Food hygiene (2 weeks, abroad)
