

APPLICATION FOR PANNONIA SCHOLARSHIP MOBILITY FOR STUDENTS

We would like to inform our students that our university is announcing an application call for a Pannónia scholarship **for the 2025/2026 academic year**. Students participating in the program can study or do a professional internship abroad with scholarship support, and they can also conduct research.

Long-term student mobility (basic, master, undivided, doctoral level)

- Mobility for study purposes (2-12 months)
- Professional practice and recent graduate professional practice (2-12 months)
- Mobility for research purposes (2-3 months): exclusively at master's, undivided and doctoral level; with a minimum of 7 completed semesters in the case of undivided course

Short-term student mobility (basic, master, undivided, doctoral level)

- Mobility for study purposes (2-30 days)
- Mobility for research purposes (2-30 days): exclusively at master's, undivided and doctoral level; with a minimum of 7 completed semesters in the case of undivided course

Excellence Scholarship Program

Students whose mobility is directed to a foreign higher education institution ranked in the top 250 in the Times Higher Education or Quacquarelli Symonds international higher education rankings can receive an excellence scholarship.

Student mobility of excellence (master, undivided, doctoral level)

- Mobility for academic purposes (1-6 months): at least 1 semester for a master's degree, at least 7 for an undivided degree, at least 2 completed semesters for a doctoral degree
- Mixed mobility: with physical and online participation, in which case the support goes to the students for the duration of the physical mobility

Application conditions:

- at least 7 completed semesters for undergraduate applicants, at least 1 completed semester for PhD students.



- active student status at the time of application and at the time of mobility as well (you have not obtained your diploma yet or PhD before the student exchange),
- adequate and high-level language skills (minimum intermediate level, type C language exam in English or the working language of the target country)
- can only be used once per training level (basic, master, doctoral).
- in case of PhD students, a formal and signed support letter is needed from your supervisor.

Evaluation criteria based on the scholarship average of the previous completed semester.

The amount of the scholarship may vary depending on the duration of the program and the destination country. Additional equal opportunity scholarship support is possible (in the case of general student mobility, based on certified documents).

An important operating principle of Pannónia program is that the sending and receiving institution must agree on a mutually suitable study/training plan (Learning Agreement), based on which the sending institution completes all the work at the receiving university (listening to lectures, participating in exercises, etc.) 75 can recognize in the case of % identity.

Study plans are drawn up based on consultation with successful applicants.

Additional information and recommendations before submitting the application:

- The main goal of the program is for students to earn credits abroad, and for the university to count them toward their studies at home. The student applying for the scholarship must organize his studies abroad in such a way that, in the first month of the diligence period after his return, he acquires at least 10 credits, which can be counted towards his studies at home, with his studies abroad, or proves his compulsory internship. Therefore, it is recommended to think about the study abroad program before submitting the application, and to prepare for the fact that the exams can be completed with a stay abroad of at least 4-5, in some cases 6 months. It is advisable to request an individual study schedule for the semester you are traveling abroad, because you will probably also have to pass exams at home to complete the given semester.
- It is worth finding out in advance about the host university, its educational profile, the subjects that can be taken, language options, and the start and end times of each semester. The website address and other information of all partner universities can be found at the following address:

- Only students who have an active student status (full-time, correspondence, PhD) in the 2024/2025 academic year may submit their application. An active student status is a prerequisite for traveling abroad. If a student has a student status at the time of application, but no longer has it at the time of departure (e.g. inactive or passive), he loses his right to the trip and the scholarship.
- The amount of the scholarship does not necessarily cover the costs incurred in the host country. (For and estimate, in the year 2024/2025, the grant amount was HUF 350,000-400,000/month, depending on the destination country. In the case of short-term: HUF 5,000-30,000/day, depending on the destination country and duration. Additional equal opportunities scholarship for part-time training: 100,000 HUF/month, in the case of short-term mobility: HUF 2,500/day)
