REQUIREMENTS FOR PARASITOLOGICAL PRACTICES

2024/2025 Second Semester

General regulations

Students should please wear their own, favorably white lab coat.

It is forbidden to consume meals, drinks or to use mobile phone, laptop in the practical room.

It is not allowed to take pictures or sound records in the practical room.

Students should follow the regulations of fire protection and safety instructions (reviewed in the 1st practice).

Maximum number of students is 18 per group. No change of group is allowed. Students should attend all practices with their own group and should arrive in time accurately.

Assessment of knowledge

As shown in the schedule, there is a test based on the practical hand-outs (and in protozoology, lecture note figures) at the beginning of the practice (5 multiple choice questions: 1 correct answer out of 4 in case of each question). At least 2 questions should be answered correctly to get pass mark. The results of the tests will be shown during the next practice. Anyone not passing the test must repeat it from the given topic(s). It is not possible to repeat the test to improve pass marks (2-4).

Missing from the practice

The missed practice must be completed in a week by watching the MS Teams video on the relevant topic (available in Moodle) recorded by the course leader; and by oral exam or written test from the given topic.

Midterms

There are two midterm examinations from the previous practical topics during the semester. On these midterm exams each student will get macroscopic preparations, two slide preparations and pictures to recognize. The practical midterm exams must be done (or if missed due to an official, medical reason: repeated) with the original group of the student. It is not possible to repeat the midterm to improve pass marks (2-4). Students who did not achieve the first midterm, are not allowed to continue with the practices of the second major topic.

Prerequisites for completing the semester (i.e., getting the signature)

Participation on the practices, passing all written tests and midterm exams. The number of failed tests and missed practices cannot exceed 3 within a semester (except if missing due to official or medical reason which should be certified towards the course leader). In case of 4 or more failed tests and missed practices the student must take an exam with the course leader from all topics of the semester.

Final practical mark of the semester

It will be calculated according to the results of two midterm exams, which may be modified by the results of the tests. The course leaders will also consider the failed entrance tests.
